

#### From Pastor Kent's Desk



For me, Lent serves as a journey, a metaphorical one filled with twists and turns which ends at the foot of a cross in Jerusalem. I've faithfully made the journey for over 60 years in a variety of settings: Los Angeles, Glendora, Seoul, Pasadena, Riverside, Richmond, Dearborn, Punxsutawney, and Lancaster. Each of the

Their goal is to refresh our hearts and minds as we walk along the road.

So, let's hold each other in prayer as we walk and talk. Let's be sensitive to the joys and concerns of our fellow travelers. I need you as much as you need me – that's what makes us a community. The Risen Christ walks with us, encouraging and

sustaining us, opening our eyes and ears to the needs of those around us. And, when we arrive, let's plan to gather in the garden on Easter Morning to celebrate the extraordinary event we call The Resurrection.
